The experience will include visits to sites such as the Scar Tree and Tom Wills statue as well as the introduction to artefacts related to marn-grook and Welcome to Country ceremonies. Suitable for primary Years 3 and above.

45 minute interactive presentation plus 1 hour MCG Tour.
